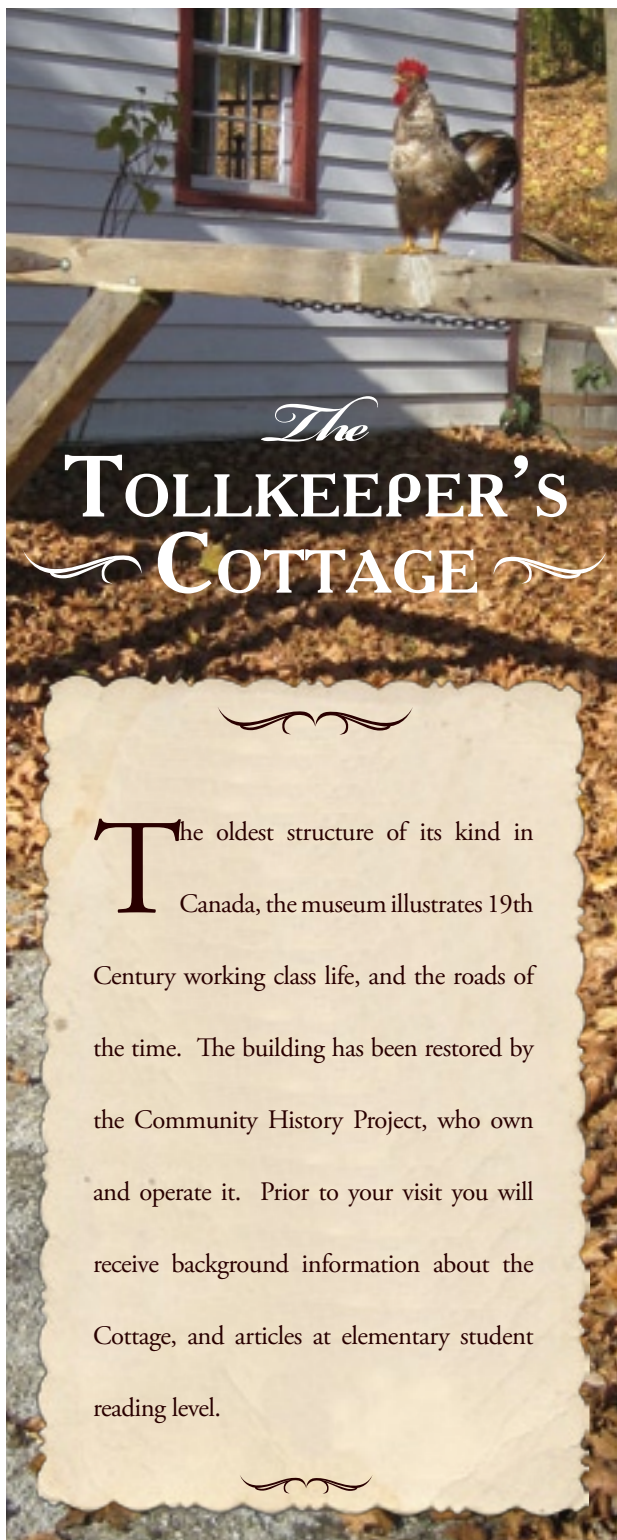




VICTORIAN CHILDREN'S OUTDOOR GAMES
